

Instructions for Scheduling your Charter Trip

1. Contact Captain Andy of Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service by phone or email to check the availability of the date(s) you would like.
2. Once the availability of your date(s) is confirmed, review the “Terms and Conditions for Charter Services” and “Cancellation Policy” sections.
3. Fill out and sign the “Agreement” page.
4. Mail the “Agreement” and your deposit to Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service.

Terms and Conditions for Charter Services

The following terms and conditions must be agreed upon and signed prior to the commencement of the Charter Service. These terms and conditions also exonerate the Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service from further liability and responsibility in the case of accidents and/or personal/property damage due to the breach of these terms and conditions. Responsibility of Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service will herein be defined as a liability of services, monetary reimbursement for appropriate cancellations, and the assurance of safety as a result of this agreement for Charter Services.

1. In the case of adverse weather and/or conditions, the Captain may terminate further services to protect the participants(s) of the activity.
2. The use of illegal drugs will terminate the Charter Service with no further responsibility of Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service.
3. If during Charter Services the use of alcohol becomes excessive and/or jeopardizes the safety of the Captain and/or associates or the participant(s) of the activity, the Captain may terminate the service at no reimbursement (\$0) to the participant(s).
4. Swimming and other entry to the water for reasons other than in the case of emergency under specific direction of the Captain or United States Coast Guard is not permitted and is outside of the responsibility of Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service.
5. The participant(s) must provide their own clothing that is appropriate for the weather for the time of the Charter Service activity.
6. Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service is not responsible for the use, damage, and/or security of personal items and property.
7. The purchase and possession of the appropriate New York State sporting licenses and stamps is the sole responsibility of the participant(s) of the Charter Service.
8. Charter Services will not commence if the proper New York State sporting license requirements are not met.
9. The use of personal flotation devices (PFD) is required in correspondence with New York State and United States Coast Guard laws and requirements.

10. Refusal to use the proper PFD in accordance with New York State and the United States Coast Guard laws and requirements will terminate the responsibility of the Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service and the trip may be cancelled.
11. All participants under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 and are not the responsibility of the Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service for any service other than the Charter Service.
12. If the person hiring the Charter Service is not the parent or legal guardian of the under age participant(s), they must obtain written permission from the parent or legal guardian.
13. All photography or video collected by Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service may be used freely for promotional purposes whether by website, electronic or print publications.

Cancellation Policy

1. Cancellation of the Charter Service by the Captain prior to the commencement of the Charter Service due to adverse weather or mechanical problems will allow the rescheduling of the Charter Service or a refund of the full deposit to the participant(s).
2. Cancellation of the Charter Service by the participant(s) prior to the commencement of the Charter Services must be made in writing no less than 30 days prior the scheduled date of the Charter Service for a full refund of the deposit.
3. Cancellation by the participant(s) less than 30 days prior to the scheduled Charter Service may receive no refund of the deposit.
4. Broad Horizons Guide and Charter Service is not responsible for reimbursement of the cost of New York State sporting licenses in the case of cancellation.

Checklist for your trip

1. Current New York State fishing license
2. Rainwear and Outerwear appropriate for the season. It is usually a little cooler on the water.
3. Soft-soled shoes
4. Hat and Sunglasses
5. Sunscreen lotion, please do not bring spray sunscreen.
6. Camera, film and batteries.
7. Food, beverages, and a lunch cooler. Please do not bring glass bottles.
8. Cooler for transporting your catch home.
9. Motion sickness medication. Dramamine, Ginger gum or pills, Seaband wristbands.

Agreement

I understand that some of these conditions are arbitrary and rely on the discretion of the Captain.
